

“We artificially inseminated over 300 Beefmaster cows to Akaushi bulls, and we were shocked by the thickness and straight appearance of their calves. The calves had small birth weights which gave us 100% calving ease. They hit the ground and started growing with no supplementation during a drought year. They weaned over 600 lbs. average at 6.5 months of age. The first set of 60 Akaushi/Beefmasters have gone through a USDA facility and were graded 86% choice and 14% Prime, no Select. They had an average yield grade of three, with no yield grade ones or fives. The average rib-eye area was 14.2 cm.”
